



Aun Aprendo—I am still learning.






WELCOME TO BESANT HILL SCHOOL







SAT

STEM

Ideal for students interested in pursuing a career in science, technology, engineering, or mathematics (STEM). The BHS Summer STEM Program is an intensive, four-week experience that immerses students in hands-on engineering design and problem-solving.
